<sup>22:22</sup> “Do not take advantage of the widow or the fatherless. <sup>23</sup> If you do and they cry out to me, I will certainly hear their cry. <sup>24</sup> My anger will be aroused, and I will kill you with the sword; your wives will become widows and your children fatherless. <sup>25</sup> “If you lend money to one of my people among you who is needy, do not treat it like a business deal; charge no interest. <sup>26</sup> If you take your neighbor’s cloak as a pledge, return it by sunset, <sup>27</sup> because that cloak is the only covering your neighbor has. What else can they sleep in? When they cry out to me, I will hear, for I am compassionate. <sup>28</sup> “Do not blaspheme God or curse the ruler of your people.”
