## **Exodus 29:38,42-43**

<sup>29:38</sup> “This is what you are to offer on the altar regularly each day: two lambs a year old.” <sup>42</sup>For the generations to come this burnt offering is to be made regularly at the entrance to the tent of meeting, before the LORD. There I will meet you and speak to you; <sup>43</sup>there also I will meet with the Israelites, and the place will be consecrated by my glory.”

## **Leviticus 9:23-24**

<sup>9:23</sup> “Moses and Aaron then went into the tent of meeting. When they came out, they blessed the people; and the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people. <sup>24</sup>Fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the fat portions on the altar. And when all the people saw it, they shouted for joy and fell facedown.”

## **Jeremiah 20:9**

<sup>20:9</sup> “But if I say, “I will not mention his word or speak anymore in his name, “his word is in my heart like a fire, a fire shut up in my bones. I am weary of holding it in; indeed, I cannot.”

## **Romans 12:1-2**

<sup>12:1</sup> “Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. <sup>2</sup>Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”
