### **Leviticus 10:10**

<sup>10:10</sup> “So that you can distinguish between the holy and the common, between the unclean and the clean.”

### **Numbers 19:17-19**

<sup>19:17</sup> “For the unclean person, put some ashes from the burned purification offering into a jar and pour fresh water over them. <sup>18</sup> Then a man who is ceremonially clean is to take some hyssop, dip it in the water and sprinkle the tent and all the furnishings and the people who were there. He must also sprinkle anyone who has touched a human bone or a grave or anyone who has been killed or anyone who has died a natural death. <sup>19</sup> The man who is clean is to sprinkle those who are unclean on the third and seventh days, and on the seventh day he is to purify them. Those who are being cleansed must wash their clothes and bathe with water, and that evening they will be clean.”

### **Romans 13:13-14**

<sup>13:13</sup> “Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy. <sup>14</sup> Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh.”

### **Hebrews 13:10-13**

<sup>13:10</sup> “We have an altar from which those who minister at the tabernacle have no right to eat.”

<sup>11</sup> “The high priest carries the blood of animals into the Most Holy Place as a sin offering, but the bodies are burned outside the camp. <sup>12</sup> And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood. <sup>13</sup> Let us, then, go to him outside the camp, bearing the disgrace he bore.”
